7 tips for more skiing pleasure

- At your holiday accommodation, use security facilities such as lockable ski storage rooms, ski- and ski boot lockers or lockable ski racks.
- Do not leave keys to such secure storage facilities unattended.
- Be aware of who enters ski storage rooms at your accommodation; often, thieves enter ski rooms together with hotel guests to spy facilities.
- Do not carelessly leave your skis in the snow in front of a mountain lodge.
- Keep your sports equipment within eyeshot and never leave it unattended.
- Separate skis and put them in two different places. Thieves do not take the time to look for matching skis to put them together.
- Secure your snowboard with a steel cable or bicycle lock to any fixture.

What to do in case of a theft?

If your equipment has been stolen, please report to police. Your insurance will demand a copy of the police report filed. It does help if you have serial- or production numbers of your skis and binding, and any documentation handy when filing the police report.
